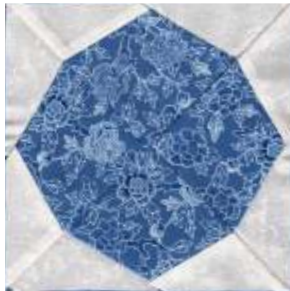

The Crossroads Quilt is set on point, you make 41 - 6" finished blocks using the
Starla Stash Buster(Guided Template)
Hoshi Stash Buster(Guided Template)
18" Adjustable Ruler

Block 1 make 9
STARLA



Block 2 make 16
STARLA - HOSHI



Block 3 make 16
Striped Block



Fabric Requirements

Background Fabric (White) **180 cm**

Focus Fabric 1 (Dark Blue) **40 cm**

Focus Fabric 2 (Blue) **120 cm**

Using a standard 44" wide fabric. All strips cut across width of fabric, 4 layers

Tools Required:

Starla Stash Buster Set,

Hoshi Stash Buster Set,

Setting Triangle and Corner Setting Triangle

Adjustable Ruler 18" or 24"

Cutting - *Fold your full width of fabric in half and then fold again. This will allow easy cutting for the reverse pieces when required.*

Follow the instructions that come with each tool to set the Adjustable Ruler to cut the strips

Background Fabric

Bg1   Bg1 R

- Cut 64 using **Tool A** from the **STARLA** Set
- Cut 64 reverse using **Tool A** from the **STARLA** Set

Bg2   Bg2 R

- Cut 16 using **Tool C** from the **HOSHI** Set
- Cut 16 reverse using **Tool C** from the **HOSHI** Set

Bg3   Bg3 R

- Cut 16 using **Tool A** from the **HOSHI** Set
- Cut 16 reverse using **Tool A** from the **HOSHI** Set

Bg4 

- Cut 32 3" x 6 1/2" rectangles



Bg5 

- Cut 16 6" Setting Triangles (make sure Bias is right place - as shown on the triangle)

Bg6 

- Cut 4 6" Corner Setting Triangles (make sure Bias is right place - as shown on the triangle)

Focus Fabric 1 (Dark Blue)

Db1   Db1R

- Cut 16 using **Tool B** from the **HOSHI** Set
- Cut 16 reverse using **Tool B** from the **HOSHI** Set

Db2 

- Cut 16 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

Binding

- Binding cut 5 2 1/2" strips

Focus Fabric 2 (Blue)

B1 

- Cut 68 using **Tool B** from the **STARLA** Set

Block 1

STARLA

Make 9

Lay out the block before piecing

ALWAYS PIN

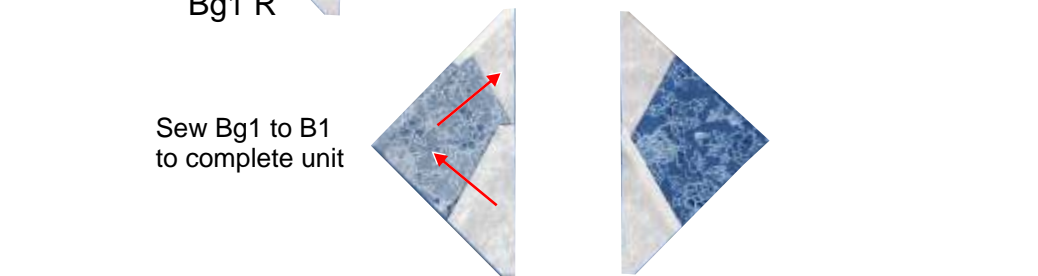
Sew using a SCANT QUARTER INCH SEAM ALLOWANCE

Press each seam before sewing the next

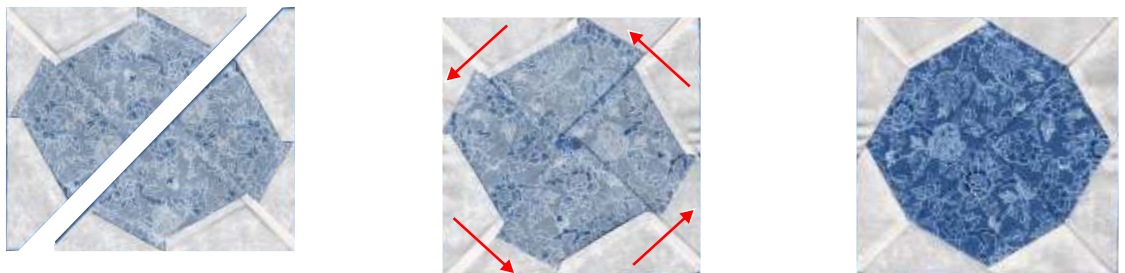
Red Arrows show pressing direction



**Unit 1
Make 36**



Sew units together to make a Half Square Triangle



Sew Half Square Triangles together to complete the Starla Block

Block 2

STARLA - HOSHI

Make 16 and 16 reverse

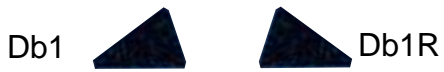
Lay out the block before piecing

ALWAYS PIN

Sew using a SCANT QUARTER INCH SEAM ALLOWANCE

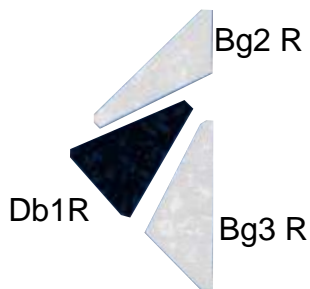
Press each seam before sewing the next

Red Arrows show pressing direction



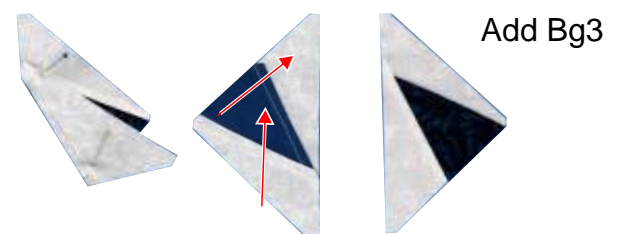
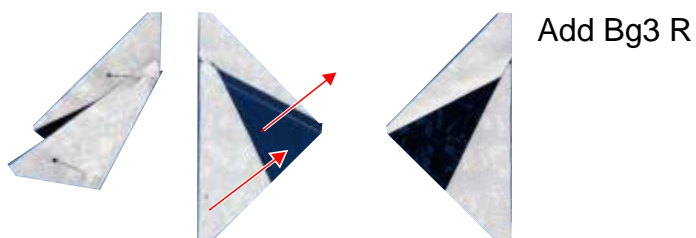
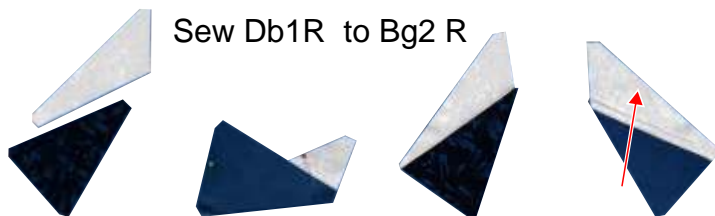
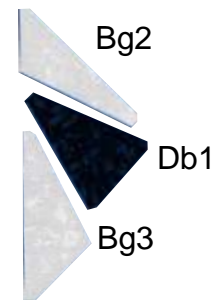
HOSHI UNIT

Make 16 unit 16 reverse units

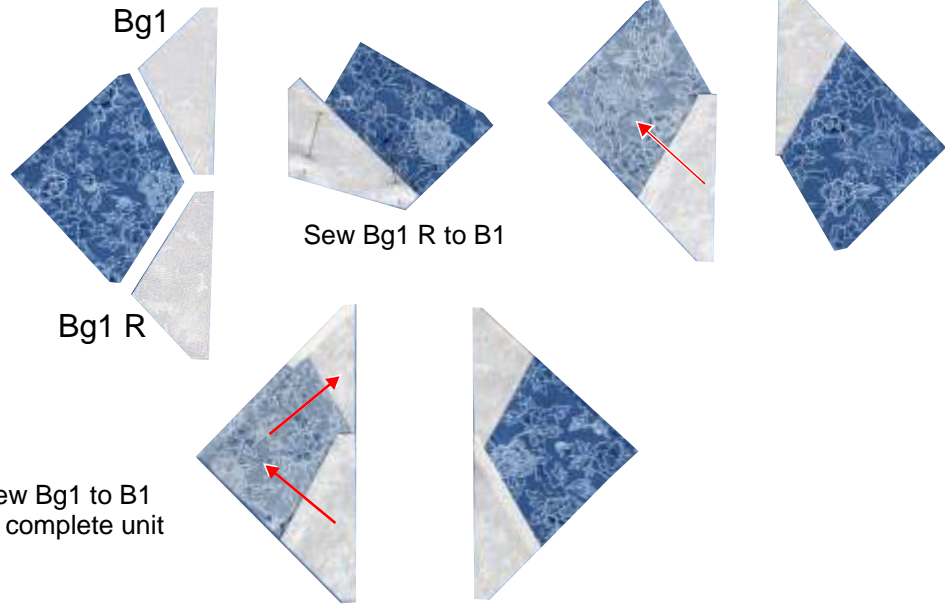


When Making the Hoshi block it is most important to layout the block.

Take special note of the direction of each piece when laying out each unit. There is only a small difference in the Hoshi B piece but an important one.



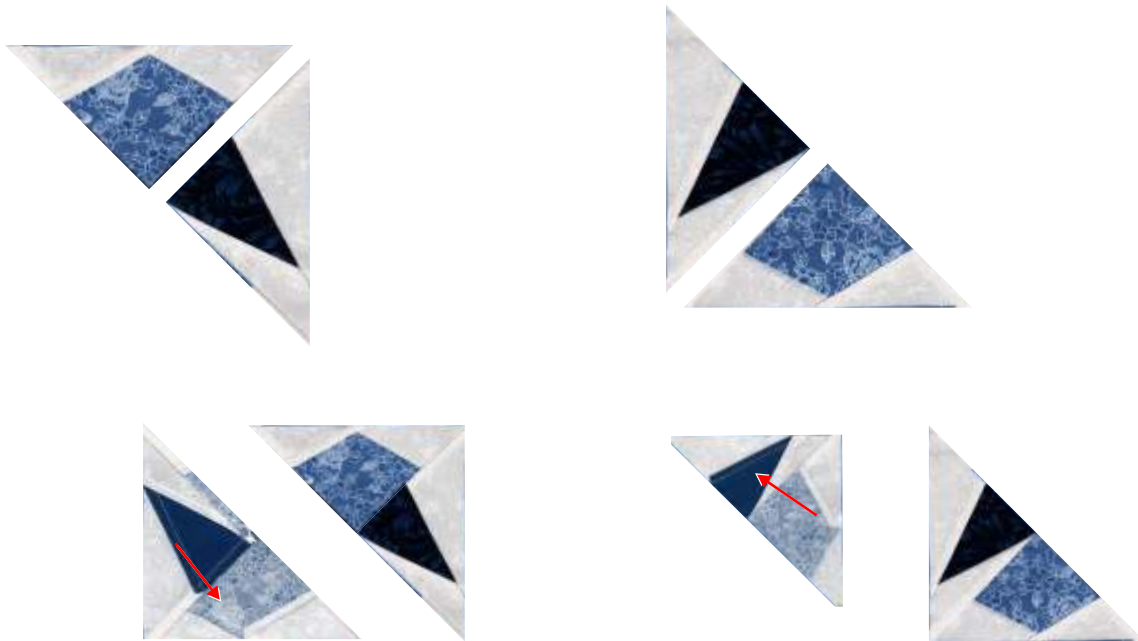

Make 32**



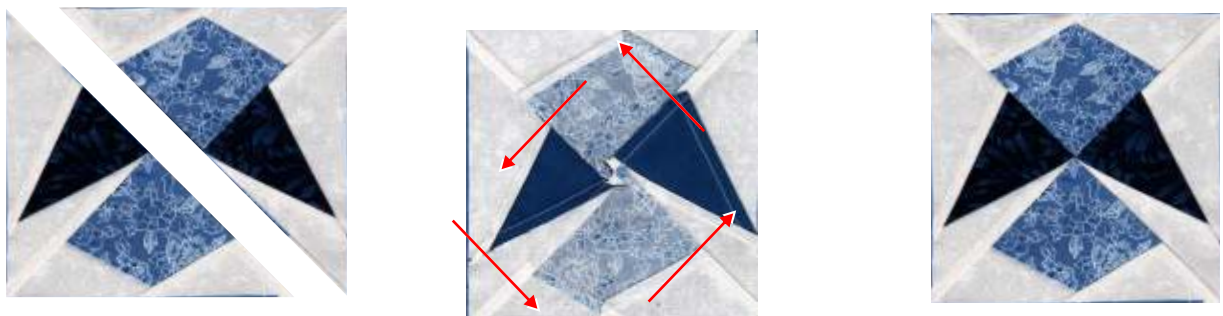
Sew Bg1 to B1

Sew STARLA unit to HOSHI unit



Sew STARLA - HOSHI units to make Half Square Triangle



Sew STARLA - HOSHI Half Square Triangles together to complete the STARLA-HOSHI Block
Make 16 blocks
