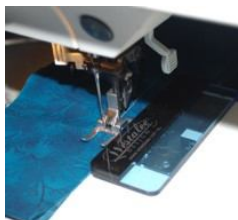
Block 1

FOUR PATCH

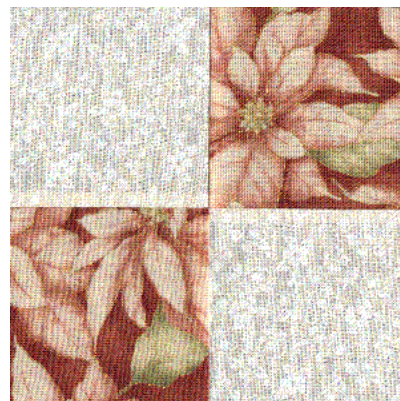
6" x 6" Finished Block

Westalee Tools used:

Adjustable Ruler 12 1/2" or 18" or 24"



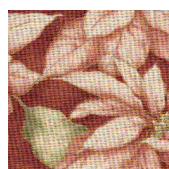

The Four Patch is the first base unit, you will find the four patch used in hundreds of different blocks and use it time and time again.

CUT

A cut 2 - 3 1/2" Squares, background fabric

Set ruler at 3 1/2"

B cut 2 - 3 1/2" Squares, focus fabric

Set ruler at 3 1/2"

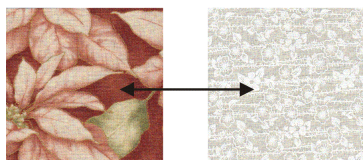
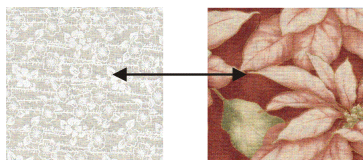
Follow the diagrams to piece units and block

The Black arrows show construction

Press the seams in the direction of the Red arrows

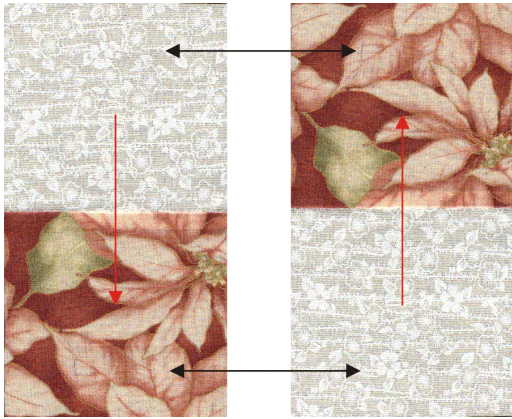


Sew using a scant Quarter Inch Seam Allowance

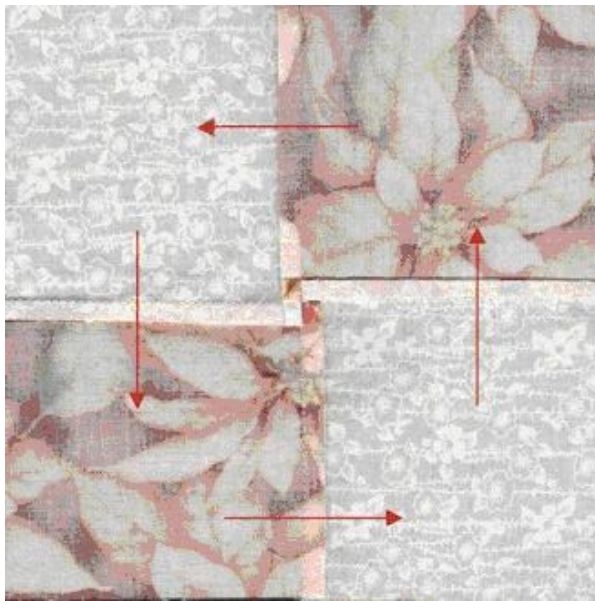


Sew
A to B

Make 2 units



Press seams in the direction of Red arrows
Sew units together



Spiral Seams Gently tease the stitches of the seams apart at the centre of the block. The seams can now be pressed in opposite directions, giving beautiful flat seam intersections with less bulk at the intersections.



TIP:

*Always press your fabric before cutting .
Crease and folds in the fabric can make your cuts inaccurate, making it difficult to piece your blocks.*
