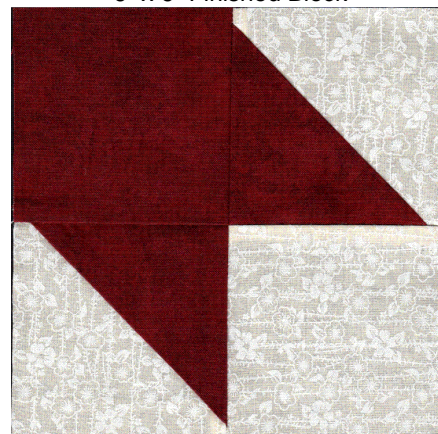
Block 20

HOMeward BOUND 6" x 6" Finished Block

Westalee Tools used:

Adjustable Ruler 12 1/2" or 18" or 24"

Half Square Triangle

CUT

A Use your Half Square Triangle adjusted to 3" to set your Adjustable Ruler. With your Focus fabric and Background Fabric, right sides facing, cut a strip on the **bias** long enough to get 2 x 3" Half Square Triangles

Sew the strip down both sides to create a tube (Scant Quarter)

B cut 1 - 3 1/2" Square Background fabric

Set Adjustable Ruler at 3 1/2"

C cut 1 - 3 1/2" Square Focus fabric

Set Adjustable Ruler at 3 1/2"

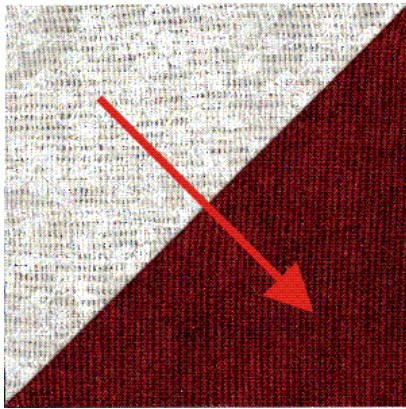
Follow the diagrams to piece units and block

The Black arrows show construction

Press the seams in the direction of the Red arrows

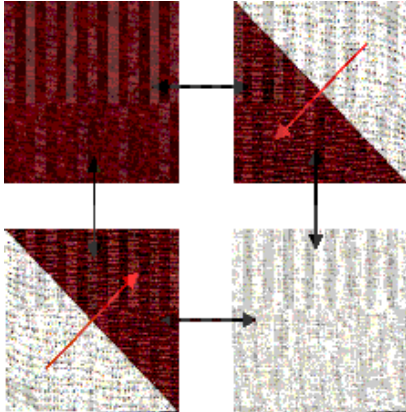


Sew using a scant Quarter Inch Seam Allowance

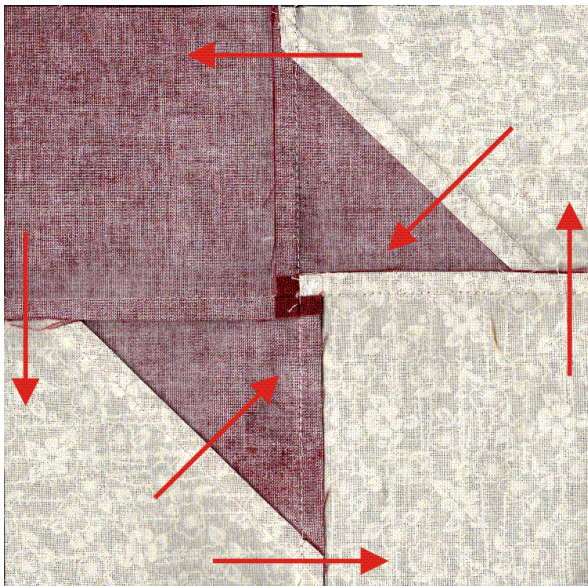


Make 2 Half Square Triangle units using A and B

Press seam allowance to the focus fabric



Join the Half Square Triangle units and squares as shown



Press seam in direction of arrows and spiral the centre seam intersection seam

TIP:

Press each seam as you sew. Press well - keeping seams flat with no twist
Extra care at this stage will result in a much better quilt.
