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Block 27

Westalee Tools used:

Adjustable Ruler 12 1/2" or 18" or 24"

Half Square Triangle

HOURLASS VARIATION

6" x 6" Finished Block

CUT

A cut 4 - 2" Squares - Background fabric

B cut 4 - 2" Squares - Focus Fabric

C Use your Half Square Triangle adjusted to 3" to set your Adjustable Ruler. With your Focus Fabric and Background Fabric, right sides facing, cut out enough strips on the bias to make 2 Half Square Triangles (Sew the bias edges of the strip.)

Follow the diagrams to piece units and block

The Black arrows show construction

Press the seams in the direction of the Red arrows



Sew using a scant Quarter Inch Seam Allowance

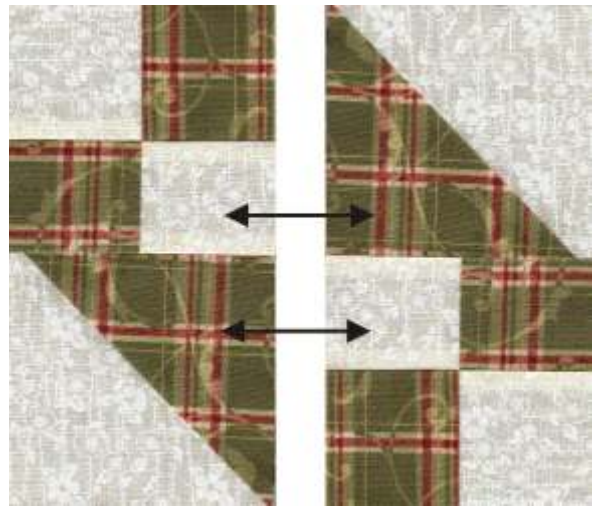
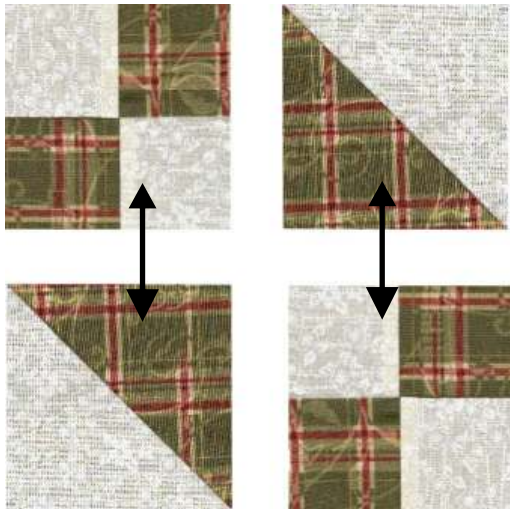


Make 4 Four Patch units

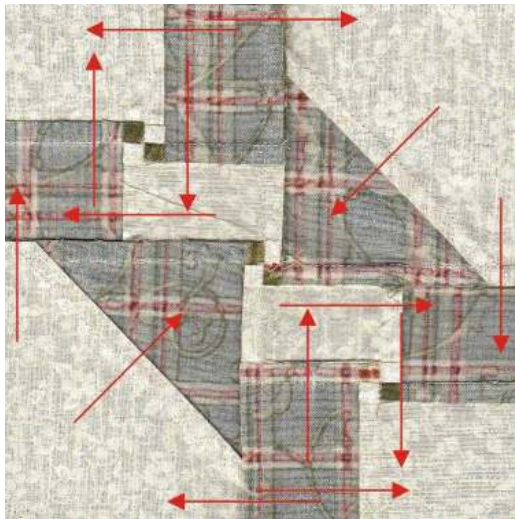
As in Block 1



Cut out your 2 x 3" (finished size) Half Square Triangle units from the prepared fabric tube



Sew pieces into rows then make your block



Press seams as indicated

TIP:

Where possible press seam allowance in opposite directions to make nesting seams easy
