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Block 54

Westalee Tools used:

Adjustable Ruler 12 1/2" or 18" or 24"

Half Square Triangle 2" to 6"

Square in the Square Trim Guide

SNOWBALL

6" x 6" Finished Block



A



B

CUT

A cut 1 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" Background Fabric

B cut 4 - Half Square Triangles with tool set at 2 1/2"

Follow the diagrams to piece units and block

The Black arrows show construction

Press the seams in the direction of the Red arrows



Sew using a scant Quarter Inch Seam Allowance



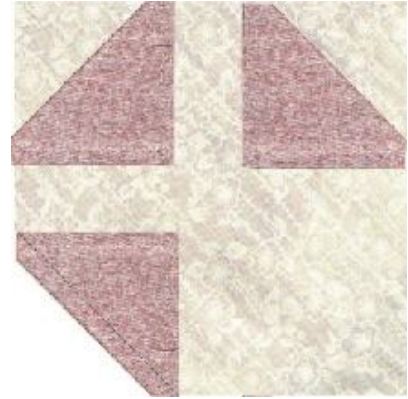
Using the Square in the Square Trim Guide cut the corners off each of the half square triangle pieces.

NB: It is right angle cut from each of the short sides on the piece.



With **A** facing up place **B** facing down on **A**.
Line up the trimmed corners with the edge of the square.

Pin in place. Repeat for each corner



Cut off the corner of **A**

Repeat for each corner



Sew and press seams outwards

TIP:
I like to lay my blocks out so that when I go to sew the pieces and units together I do not sew them together incorrectly.
