6" x 6" Finished Block

### Westalee Tools used:

Adjustable Ruler 12 1/2" or 18" or 24"

Adjustable Half Square Triangle 2" to 6"

Adjustable Quarter Square Triangle " to 6"

Square in the Square Trim Guide

### CUT

**A** cut 1 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Square Focus Fabric

**B** cut 4 - 2" Half Square Triangle Focus Fabric 1

**C** Set the Adjustable ruler to 1 1/2" and cut a strip of Background Fabric 18" wide.

- Set the Quarter Square Triangle to 4" and cross cut the strip to get 4 **C** pieces.

Follow the diagrams to piece units and block

The Black arrows show construction

Press the seams in the direction of the Red arrows



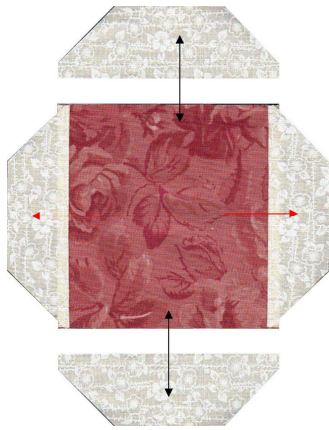
### Sew using a scant Quarter Inch Seam Allowance



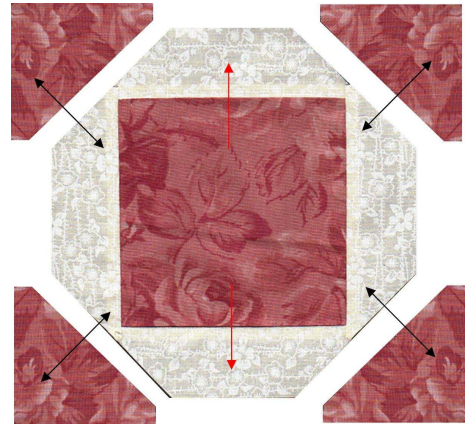
Trim piece **C** with the Square in the Square Trim Guide.

Join piece **C** to **A**





Sew all **C** pieces and press open



Sew **B** pieces to complete the block



Press seams to the outside
