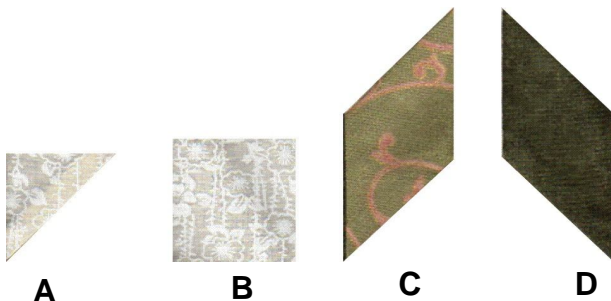
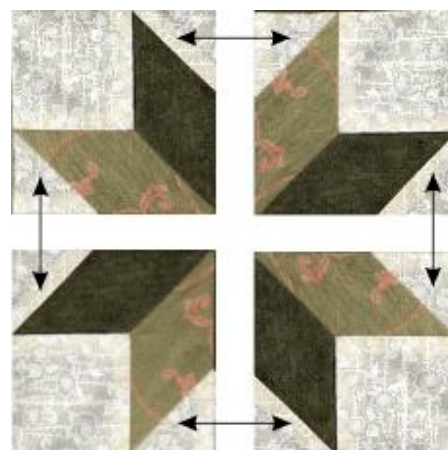
Block 86

LE MOYNE STAR 6" x 6" Finished Block

Westalee Tools used:

Adjustable Ruler 12 1/2" or 18" or 24"

Miniature Adjustable Quarter Square
Triangle



CUT

A cut 8 - pieces of Background Fabric. Set Miniature Quarter Square Triangle to 1 3/4"

*NOTE: The Quarter Square Triangle is used here as the measurement of this piece is not a Half Square Measurement. (You do need, in this case only, to ignore the bias markings on the Quarter Square Triangle tool. **Remember to cut piece A on the Bias, as you would for a Half Square Triangle.** This puts the bias on the inside of the block.*

B cut 4 - squares of Background Fabric Set Adjustable Ruler at 2 1/4"

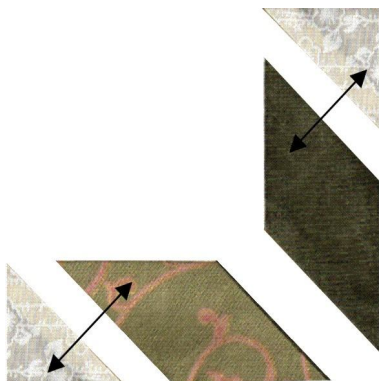
C cut 4 - 45 Degree Diamonds with Adjustable Ruler set at 1 3/4" from Focus Fabric 1

D cut 4 - 45 Degree Diamonds with Adjustable Ruler set at 1 3/4" from Focus Fabric 2

Follow the diagrams to piece units and block
The Black arrows show construction
Press the seams in the direction of the Red arrows

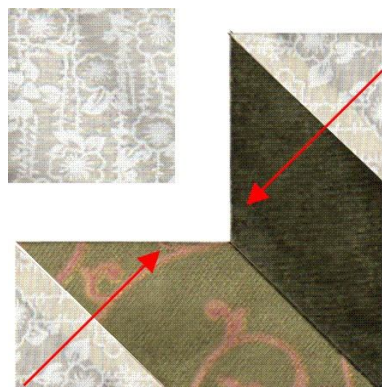


Sew using a scant Quarter Inch Seam Allowance

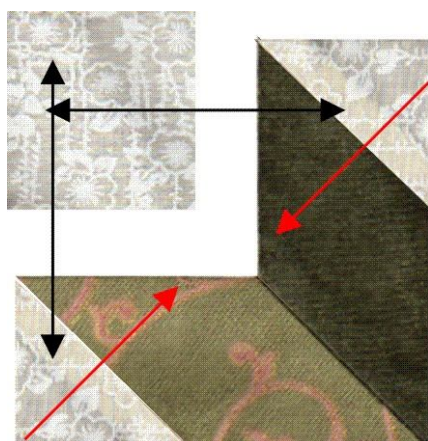


Unit 1
Sew Diamond C to Triangle A
Make 4

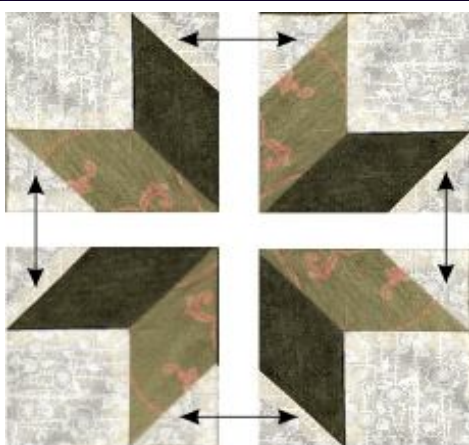
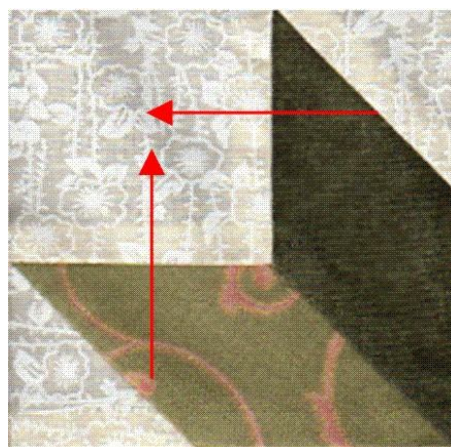
Unit 2
Sew Diamond D to Triangle A
Make 4



Unit 3
Sew Unit 1 to Unit 2
Make 4



Unit 4
Using the Y seam
technique sew Square B to
Unit 3
Make 4 (**“Y” seam video
on our web site**)



Join all 4 units to
complete block
