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Block 88

Westalee Tools used:

Adjustable Ruler 12 1/2" or 18" or 24"

Adjustable Miniature Half Square Triangle

Adjustable Quarter Square Triangle

6" x 6" Finished Block

There are a couple of ways to make this block, however, the one I have used here is designed to be a skill building exercise and uses several of tools you now have.

CUT

A cut - 2 Quarter Square Triangles form the Background Fabric, Set Quarter Square triangle to 6"

B cut - 6 Half Square Triangles form Background Fabric. Set Miniature Half Square triangle to 1" (Cut from strip cut on the bias)

C cut - 12 Quarter Square Triangles from Focus Fabric. Set Quarter Square Triangle to 2" (Cut from strip cut on straight of grain)

Follow the diagrams to piece units and block

The Black arrows show construction

Press the seams in the direction of the Red arrows



Sew using a scant Quarter Inch Seam Allowance



Make 2 Flying Geese Units using B and C
Unit 1



Make 4 Flying Geese Units. Leave off right hand sky
Unit 2



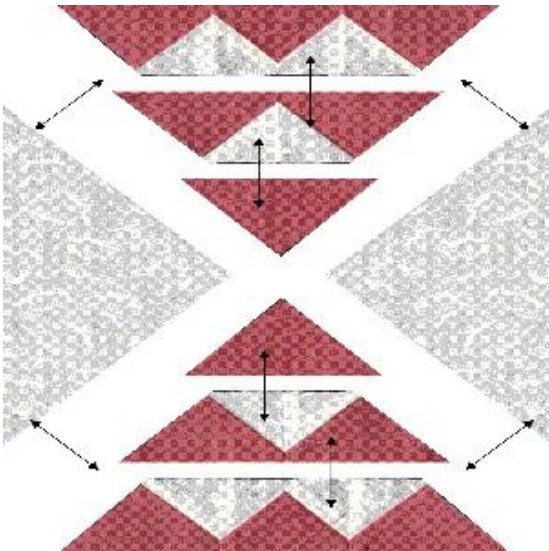
Make 4 Flying Geese Units. Leave off left hand sky
Unit 3



Join Unit 3 (on left) to Unit 2. Make 2



Join Unit 1 (middle) to Unit 2 and Unit 3 Make 2



Join your rows

Join the pieced quarter square triangles to A

Complete the Block



Press seams as shown
