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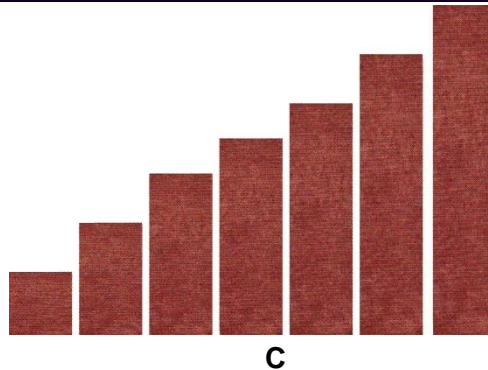
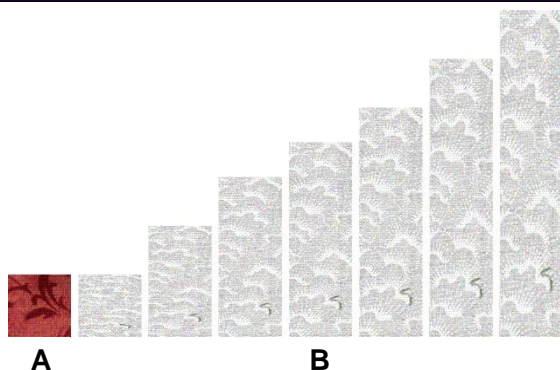
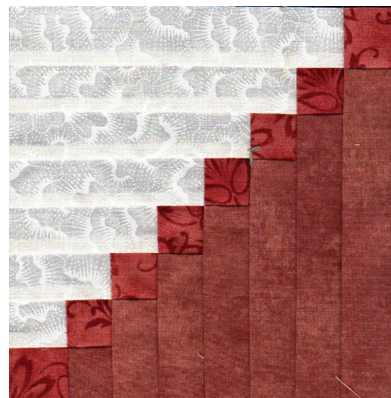
## Block 95

### Westalee Tools used:

Adjustable Ruler 12 1/2" or 18" or 24"

### STAIRWAY TO HEAVEN

6" x 6" Finished Block



### CUT

**A** - cut 8 squares 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" Focus Fabric 1 (steps, shown as patterned fabric)

**B & C** - cut a strip 1 1/4" of Background Fabric and Focus Fabric 2, (minimum 25" each).

Crosscut to:

1 1/4" x 1 1/4"

1 1/4" x 2"

1 1/4" x 2 3/4"

1 1/4" x 3 1/2"

1 1/4" x 4 1/4"

1 1/4" x 5"

1 1/4" x 5 3/4"

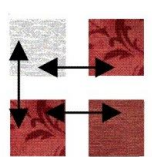
Follow the diagrams to piece units and block

The Black arrows show construction

Press the seams in the direction of the Red arrows



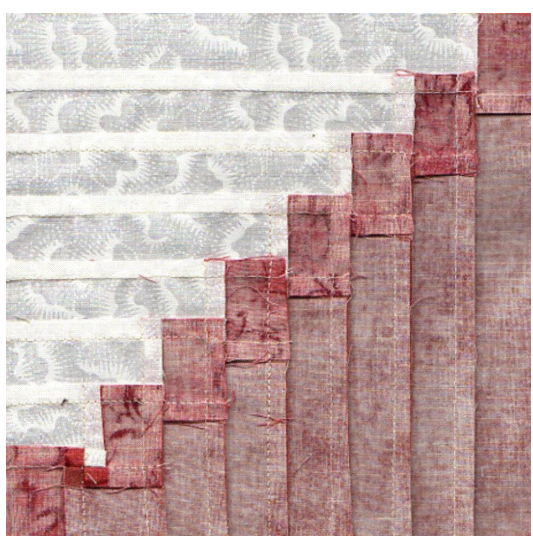
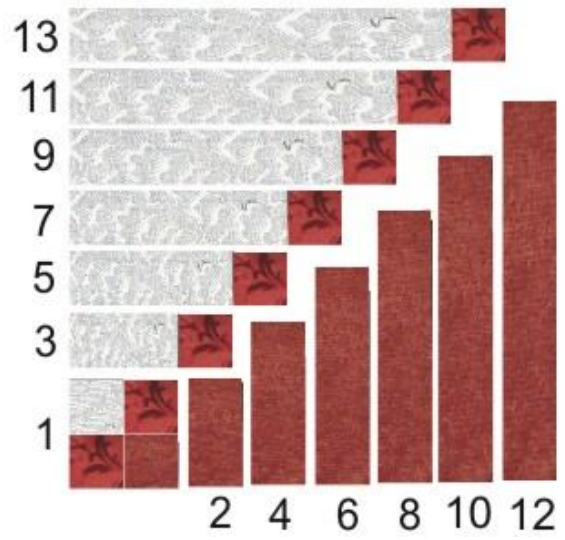
**Sew using a scant Quarter Inch Seam Allowance**



Begin at the bottom left hand corner with the 1 1/4" pieces, by sewing Focus fabric 1 to Background fabric then join Focus Fabric 1 to Focus Fabric 2, join the two to create **unit 1**

Build your block by starting with unit 1 and following the sequence shown on the left, join each piece to complete the block.

Press the seams as you sew each piece.
