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Block 99

QUARTER INCH BARS 6" x 6" Finished Block

Westalee Tools used:

Adjustable Ruler 12 1/2" or 18" or 24"

I would recommend you watch our video "Cutting Narrow Strips" on the Instructions page of our web site. before you commence this block.

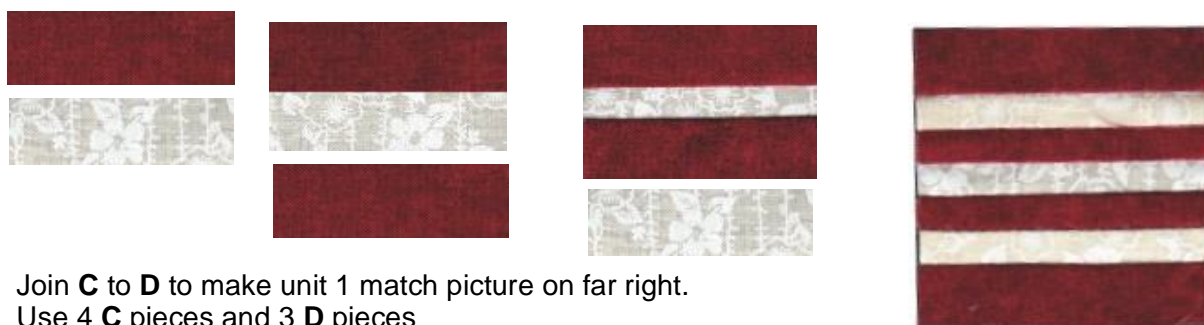
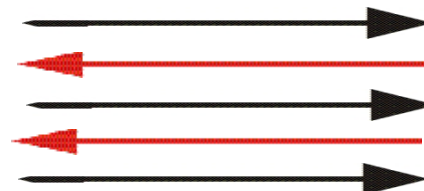


CUT

- A** cut 2 - Strips 7/8" X 6 1/2" of Focus Fabric
- B** cut 2 - Strips 7/8" X 5 3/4" of Focus Fabric
- C** cut 16 - Strips 3/4" X 2 1/4" of Focus Fabric
- D** cut 12 - Strips 3/4" X 2 1/4" of Background Fabric
- E** cut 5 - Squares 2 1/4" X 2 1/4" of Background Fabric

Sew using a scant Quarter Inch Seam Allowance

Follow the diagrams to piece units and block.
When sewing the small strips, change the sewing direction each strip. This will help avoid fabric distortion.



Join **C** to **D** to make unit 1 match picture on far right.

Use 4 **C** pieces and 3 **D** pieces

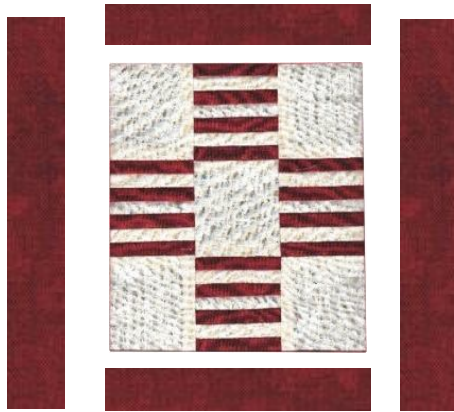
Make sure you are sewing with a SCANT Quarter Inch

Using a Stiletto helps keep these small pieces straight when sewing



Join Unit 1 to E - sew 3 rows

Join the rows to complete the centre of the block.



Sew **B** to the top and Bottom of the center unit.

Sew **A** to the sides to complete the block

TIP:

When pressing have a look at the seam you have sewn - if it is not correct now is the time to fix any problems
